CHLAMYDIA

Chlamydia is a bacterial infection that is best treated with a single-dose antibiotic

GONORRHEA

Gonorrhea is a bacterial infection that is best treated with a single-dose antibiotic

HEPATITIS B

Hepatitis B is a viral infection, the use of an antiviral will help prevent damage to the liver

HERPES

Herpes is a viral infection that can not be cured, but the use of an antiviral can help

HIV/AIDS

HIV is a viral infection that can not be cured, but the use of an antiviral can help

HPV/GENITAL WARTS

HPV is a viral infection that can not be cured, but medical assistance can help. Options include medications, cryotherapy, and surgical removal. Often times warts will go away on their own.

SYPHILIS

Syphilis is a bacterial infection that is best treated with a single-dose antibiotic

TRICHOMONIASIS ("TRICH")

Trichomoniasis, or "trich", is a parasitic infection best treated with a single-dose antibiotic

What happens if I don't get

treatment?

Not receiving the proper treatment can lead to more serious health issues such as:

- Damaged reproductive organs and other organs
- Heart conditions
- Inability to become pregnant
- Arthritis
- Cancers such as cervical cancer
- Death

HIV/AIDS Reminder!

HIV is a viral infection that can be contracted by unprotected sex, needle sharing, or contact with infected blood. HIV can lead to AIDS if not treated.
